Sponsored by the California Breastfeeding Coalition and Senator Pan’s office, the Mother-Baby Friendly Workplace Award recognizes employers that implement breastfeeding friendly policies to support working mothers.

Anderson Valley Health Center received the award on Tuesday May 23rd at the State Capitol. Stephanie Long, RN manager for AVHC, who nominated AVHC for the award, Fabiola Cornejo, Chief Operations Officer and Chloë Guazzone-Rugebregt, Executive Director were present with their babies to receive the award. The ED stated that “collectively 50% of AVHC employees are mothers and have breastfed 18 children over 22 years”.
